



## DIRECTIONS TO LEHIGH LODGE

**Driving from the East or West:** Take Interstate 80 to exit 284 (State Route 115/ Blakeslee) then take State Route 115 North to the Blakeslee corners (intersection of State Routes 940 and 115).

**Driving from the North or South:** Take the PA Turnpike NE Extension (Interstate 476) to exit 95 (State Route 940/ Hazleton) then make your first left onto State Route 940 East to the Blakeslee corners (intersection of State Routes 940 and 115).

Once at the Blakeslee corners, proceed north on State Route 115 for 3.25 miles. Once crossing the Lehigh River bridge into Luzerne County (marked with a white sign), make an **IMMEDIATE** left onto The Maples Lane. This turn comes very quickly after the bridge and is only marked with one street light at night. After the left turn onto The Maples Lane you will pass Stoddartsville Cemetery on your right and the Stull Barn on your left. Continue up the road and bear right until you come upon two driveways on your left. Take the rightmost driveway marked by a fence with large white posts. Follow this driveway into the woods and make your first left. Proceed to the left down the hill to the Lodge. Park anywhere there is gravel.
